

2020 JFCA Beef Show Exhibitor Information

We will use all 2020 JFCA Beef Show Series Guidelines/Rules. Please refer to those guidelines for all details and specifics; however a few highlights are as follows:

Showmanship-

- Divisions will be determined by age as of July 30th, 2020. Juniors (8-11), Intermediate (12-14), Senior (15 – 18 not graduated high school), and Collegiate (18-21 graduated high school).
- There will be two rings running for showmanship.
- Exhibitor is responsible for being ringside and ready to enter ring when called. No late entry to the ring will be allowed.

Bred and Owned Steers/Heifers:

- Exhibitor must mark that calf is Bred and Owned on the entry form. Bred and Owned means – **Exhibitor MUST be breeder, 1st and continuous owner of the animal! By selecting YES on entry form you are signifying that you understand what Bred & Owned means and that the exhibitor is in compliance. If this is found to be falsified, the exhibitor and animal will be disqualified from the remainder of the series and will forfeit any and all awards.**
- Bred & Owned Divisions are as follows:
 - Bred & Owned Steers (Commercial and American)
 - Bred & Owned Brahman Influenced Heifers (Registered Brahman, Registered Brangus, Brahman Influenced Heifers)
 - Bred & Owned Commercial Heifers (Commercial Heifers & AOB Heifers)

Steers

- Will be shown by weight, there will be no classification aside from American Influenced.

Bulls

- MUST have nose ring and lead!
- Commercial Bulls will show by weight, Brahman Bulls by age.
- Bulls must be less than 2 years old by July 30, 2020

Heifers

- All will be shown by weight, except for Registered Brahman Heifers, Registered Brangus Heifers, Registered AOB Heifers

- ****NO ONE will be allowed to bring cattle, equipment, ropes, chutes, etc in prior to 7 am Thursday morning!!! ANY items found in the barn prior to the 7 am release into the barn will be removed. This will be STRONGLY ENFORCED!!**
- When entering the fairgrounds with cattle/trailers, **we will ONLY use the Red Gate**. Enter off Orient Rd. and go to the right, there will be signs. **NO ONE will be permitted through the Red Gate before 7 am Thursday Morning. No early check in or stay on the grounds will be allowed.**
- **We will be pre-assigning bedding spaces to help adhere to social distancing guidelines. PLEASE note in your online application if you want to bed with/near another exhibitor and we will do our best to accommodate that request. Please make note during the entry process if you plan on bringing in and bedding your cattle in the barn (Tying up at trailers will be allowed if you would rather go that route). PLEASE only enter the exact number of head that you plan on bringing to the show. NO TACT will be allowed in the bedding area.**
- **NO MANURE IN GARBAGE CANS!** Please use specified areas ONLY!!
- **NO CATTLE ALLOWED IN RV AREA!** If cattle are found in RV area at any time you will be asked to leave the premises and your cattle will be disqualified from the show. No refund will be given and **NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule will be permitted!** All animals should only be in designated areas. If you have a question about this, please speak to a member of the Show Committee.
- Shavings will be provided in the barns. Extra bulk shavings will be available on-site, until depleted.
- Extra power has been added to the barns; however generators are encouraged and suggested.
- **NO GENERATORS are allowed in the barns.** Generators must be kept outside.
- Fans are only allowed on L brackets or on stall dividers. No butt fans will be allowed in aisle ways, due to space.
- To assist in creating a cooler environment, please plan on setting up all fans facing the North.
- All chutes are to be placed in the overhang area on the south side of the barn or on the dirt in the north barn.
- All animals will be weighed. Registered animals in the following divisions will show by age: Brahman Heifers, Brangus Heifers, AOB Heifers and Brahman Bulls. All steers, Commercial Heifers, Brahman Influenced Heifers and Commercial Bulls will be shown by weight. If you have a registered heifer, that is also a Bred & Owned entry, PLEASE have it weighed while scales are open.
- **Bulls must have nose ring and lead.**
- Commercial Bulls do not need to be registered. Brahman Bulls must be registered.

- Please bring a copy of all registration papers with you to check in! We will also check your original registration papers, so have those handy too!
- ****You MUST use an animal that you entered during showmanship or you will receive no points. This will be strongly enforced at all shows!****
- ****You must exhibit the animals that you have entered in the show in order to receive points for the class placing and overall points (if awarded). No exceptions, except under the circumstances that you have multiple entries in a class, please grab a friend to lend a hand. This will be strongly enforced at all shows!**
- Please clean beds of hay, feed, straw, etc before leaving the fairgrounds, at the conclusion of the show.
- Please help us by cleaning up after yourselves in the barn, tie-out area, trailer parking areas, etc. There will be garbage cans and manure bins scattered for your convenience.
- Once entries are sent in, there will be **NO REFUNDS! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** If you need to switch calves out, you may do so during check in.
- Once cattle are checked in at the fairgrounds, they are not allowed to leave and then re-enter. Anyone who does not follow this will be disqualified.
- No dogs allowed in barns/arena area!! Dogs are permitted in the RV lot and at your trailers.

******Please note any preprinted materials are subject to change, based on county and state COVID guidelines at time of show. We will keep you updated as needed.***

- **Disrespectful, vulgar, inappropriate behavior – including but not limited to language, underage drinking, interaction with adults, judges, show officials, will not be tolerated. Participating in any of these activities will be grounds for IMMEDIATE dismissal. The final decision of the committee will be non-negotiable.**
