

2020 OYLS Cattle Battle AND Fall Classic Points Series

Rules and Information

- ➔ The Okeechobee Youth Livestock Show's Annual Cattle Battle will be part of both the JFCA points series comprised of six shows as well as the OYLS points series comprised of the Cattle Battle and the Fall Classic. The points accumulated at the Cattle Battle will count towards BOTH the JFCA and the OYLS points series. The Fall Classic points accumulated will ONLY apply to the OYLS points series.
- ➔ Over-All awards for the OYLS points series will be given to the exhibitors with the highest points accumulated from both the August and October show in addition to the Cattle Battle and Fall Classic Awards and Premiums.

- Cattle Battle: August 28-30, 2020
- Fall Classic: October 9-11, 2020
- **Online entry link for the CATTLE BATTLE will be removed at midnight on August 20, 2020 (NO LATE ENTRIES)**

- **Entry Fees for both shows will be as follows:**
 - ➔ Showmanship - \$20.00
 - ➔ Beef Breeding, Dairy, and Steer Entries - \$35.00
 - ➔ Bred and Owned Entries for Beef exhibits and Bred-by for Dairy exhibits will charged an additional \$10.00 per applicable entry (the Bred and Owned fee will be manually selected by exhibitor in the online entry site under exhibitor fees.) You must pay the \$10.00 fee for every Bred and Owned and/or Bred-by exhibit you wish to enter. NON-PAYMENT OF THIS FEE WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY/ENTRIES BEING REMOVED FROM THE BRED/OWNED AND/OR BRED-BY COMPETITIONS.
- **Online entry link for the FALL CLASSIC will be removed at midnight on October 1, 2020. (NO LATE ENTRIES)** This SEPARATE link will be posted on the Okeechobee Youth Livestock show website and Face Book page following the completion of the Cattle Battle.

THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE WILL APPLY TO THE CATTLE BATTLE AND FALL CLASSIC

- Agri-Civic Center grounds will open at 3:00 p.m. on Friday
- **Please do NOT plan on arriving early to unload. The Health Inspector will not be on site until 3:00 p.m. You will not be allowed to unload until you have been cleared by the inspector.**
- **Check in/ Weigh In:**
4 PM - 6 PM Friday
7 AM - 9 AM Saturday

SATURDAY:

- **Showmanship:** Saturday at 12:00 PM
Ring A (Pee Wee, Junior)
Ring B (Intermediate)
Ring C (Senior, Collegiate)
- **Ring A:** Saturday @ approx. 3:30 PM Brahman Bulls followed by Commercial Bulls
- **Ring B:** Saturday @ 3:30 PM Steers (Beginning with American Steers, followed by Commercial Steers, concluding with Bred and Owned Steers)
- **DAIRY:** The Dairy Show will begin 30 minutes following the first ring to complete the steer show.
****At the conclusion of the Dairy show we will conduct a Bred-by and Supreme Overall Heifer Drive.**

SUNDAY:

- **Ring A:** Sunday 9:00 AM Brahman Heifers followed by Brahman Influence Heifers
- **Ring B:** Sunday 9:00 AM Commercial Heifers followed by Bred and Owned Heifers

****At the conclusion of both the heifer and steer shows we will conduct a Bred & Owned Drive as well as a Supreme Heifer Drive.**

- \$35.00 per entry, \$20.00 per showmanship entry
- Stall rental \$25.00/stall (130 stalls available at first come, first serve.)
- Bred and Owned and Bred-by fee \$10.00 per applicable entry
- All exhibitors will pay a \$10.00 Grounds Fee

******SCHEDULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE******

General Rules:

1. All exhibitors must be between the ages of 8-21 years as of July 30, 2020.
2. Each exhibitor/owner assumes all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
3. All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the rules for exhibition as required by the Florida Dept. of Ag & Consumer Services.
4. No entry will be permitted into barn without current health papers. A health inspector will be onsite.
5. **The owner/exhibitor is responsible for the care and cleanup of his or her animal.**
6. **Any bedding (shavings/straw) must be removed entirely before exhibitor leaves show.**
7. **Barn must be left in the condition it was found upon exhibitor's arrival.**
8. **The Main Arena will be for show rings, fitting/grooming, staging ONLY. NO CATTLE TIES WILL BE IN THE MAIN ARENA.**
9. **Power is extremely limited, and generators are recommended.**
10. **Tents are highly recommended** since exhibitors will need to be working out of their trailers.
11. There will be no maximum number of entries per exhibitor
12. There is a \$35.00 entry fee per head, \$20.00 entry for showmanship and a \$10.00 grounds fee per exhibitor. There is an additional \$10.00 fee per applicable entry for Bred/Owned and Bred-by entries.
13. Stalls can be pre-purchased for \$25.00. Stall rentals include 2 bags of shavings. **(There are only 130 stalls. They are sold via the online entry site on a first come first serve basis.)**
14. Online entries for the Cattle Battle must be completed and paid for no later than August 20, 2020 at this link, <https://oylscbps.fairwire.com/> Online entries for the Fall Classic must be completed and paid for no later than October 1, 2020. That separate link will be posted upon the completion of the Cattle Battle. **NO LATE ENTRIES**
15. Both shows to be held at Okeechobee County Agri-civic Center, Okeechobee, FL.
16. All Beef exhibitors MUST be a registered member of JFCA to qualify for points. (This is NOT applicable to Dairy exhibitors or the Fall Classic.)
17. All premium money earned will be mailed to the exhibitor at the address entered in the online entry site.
18. All beef heifers must be no older than 36 months old at time of show.
19. **All Bulls** must be no older than 24 months old as of July 30, 2020 and be shown with a nose ring.
20. NO Dairy bulls.
21. **Registered Brahman classes will be broken down by age on registration papers.**
22. Registered Brangus classes will be broken down by age. All other beef classes will be broken down by weight. Every calf / bull must be weighed in at time of entry **except for the registered Brahman cattle.**
23. **Heifer Classes will be split by breed. (AOB, Brahman Inf., Brangus, Commercial, Registered Brahman)**

Beef - Exhibitor age as of 07/30/20 (per JFCA Rules)

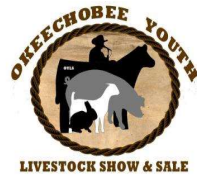
- Pee Wee 4 -7 years old

- Junior 8-11 years old
- Intermediate 12-14 years old
- Senior 15-18 years old and **not** graduated from High School
- Collegiate 18-21 and **have** graduated from High School
