Important Show Information

- ****NO ONE** will be allowed to bring cattle, equipment, ropes, chutes, etc in prior to **9 AM**
- All exhibitors must be between the ages of 8-21 years as of July 30, 2020.
- All exhibitors **MUST** be a registered member of JFCA to qualify for points.
- Exhibitor is responsible for being ringside and ready to enter ring when called. No late entry to the ring will be allowed.
- All beef heifers must be no older than 36 months old at time of show.
- All Bulls must be no older than 24 months old as of July 30, 2020 and be shown with a nose ring.
- Registered Brahman, Registered Brangus, and Registered AOB classes will be broken down by age on registration papers.
- All other beef classes will be broken down by weight. Every calf / bull must be weighed in at time of entry except for the registered cattle.
- Heifer Classes will be split by breed. (Commercial, Brahman Inf., Reg. AOB, Reg. Brangus, Reg. Brahman)
- Bulls must have nose ring and lead.
- Commercial Bulls do not need to be registered. Brahman Bulls must be registered.
- Please bring a copy of all registration papers with you to check in! We will also check your original registration papers, so have those handy too!
- ****You MUST** use an animal that you entered during showmanship or you will receive no points. This will be strongly enforced**
- ****You must exhibit the animals that you have entered in the show in order to receive points for the class placing and overall points (if awarded). No exceptions, except under the circumstances that you have multiple entries in a class, please grab a friend to lend a hand. This will be strongly enforced at all shows!**
- Please clean area of hay, feed, straw, etc before leaving, at the conclusion of the show.
- Please help us by cleaning up after yourselves in the barn and trailer parking areas, etc. There will be garbage cans scattered for your convenience. **NO MANURE IN GARBAGE CANS!** Please use specified areas **ONLY!!**
- Once entries are sent in, there will be **NO REFUNDS! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** If you need to switch calves out, you may do so during check in.
- Once cattle are checked in at the show, they are not allowed to leave and then re-enter. Anyone who does not follow this will be disqualified.
- No dogs allowed in barns/arena area!! Dogs are permitted at your trailers.
- Each exhibitor/owner assumes all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
- All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the rules for exhibition as required by the Florida Dept. of Ag & Consumer Services.
- No entry will be permitted into the facility without current health papers. A health inspector will be onsite.
The Main Arena will be for show rings and staging **ONLY**. **NO CATTLE TIES WILL BE IN THE MAIN ARENA.**
- **Power is extremely limited, and generators are recommended.**

- **Tents are highly recommended since exhibitors will need to be stalling/working out of their trailers.**
- **There are no RV hook ups on the grounds. If staying in a camper you will need to be self-contained.**
- **Only use water spigots as needed. NO hooking to trailer, porta-cools, etc.**
- There is a \$35.00 entry fee per head, \$20.00 entry for showmanship and a \$10.00 grounds fee per exhibitor. There is an additional \$10.00 fee per applicable entry for Bred/Owned and Bred-by entries.
- Online entries must be completed and paid for no later than September 14th, 2020 NO LATE ENTRIES
- Disrespectful, vulgar, inappropriate behavior – including but not limited to language, underage drinking, interaction with adults, judges, show officials, will not be tolerated. Participating in any of these activities will be grounds for IMMEDIATE dismissal. The final decision of the committee will be non-negotiable.

Showmanship:

Divisions will be determined by age as of July 30th, 2020. Juniors (8-11), Intermediate (12-14), Senior (15 – 18 not graduated high school), and Collegiate (18-21 graduated high school).

- There will be two rings running for showmanship.

Bred and Owned Steers/Heifers:

- Exhibitor must mark that calf is Bred and Owned on the entry form. Bred and Owned means –
 - Exhibitor MUST be breeder, 1st and continuous owner of the animal! By selecting YES on entry form you are signifying that you understand what Bred & Owned means and that the exhibitor in compliance is.
 - If this is found to be falsified, the exhibitor and animal will be disqualified from the remainder of the series and will forfeit any and all awards.
- Bred & Owned Divisions are as follows:
 - Bred & Owned Steers (Commercial and American)
 - Bred & Owned Brahman Influenced Heifers (Registered Brahman, Registered Brangus, Brahman Influenced Heifers)
 - Bred & Owned Commercial Heifers (Commercial Heifers & AOB Heifers)
- Bred & Owned will not have a separate show. There will be one champion drive after all of the eligible cattle have competed in their respective division/show

Steers

- Will be shown by weight, there will be no classification aside from American Influenced.

Bulls

- MUST have nose ring and lead!
- Commercial Bulls will show by weight, Brahman Bulls by age.
- Bulls must be less than 2 years old by July 30, 2020

Heifers

- All will be shown by weight, except for Registered Brahman Heifers, Registered Brangus Heifers, Registered AOB Heifers
