GOAT SHOW RULES AND SCHEDULE

Date and Schedule: Sunday, December 20, 2020
Check-in: 7:00am to 9:30am
Show starts at 10:00am
Market goats must be weighed in during check-in prior to start of the show.

Entries: Early entry deadline: December 4, 2020 (postmarked date)
Day of entries: \$25.00 late fee

General Rules: The Winter Classic Jackpot Show is open to exhibitors from the State of Florida and out of State. The show is open to all age exhibitors. Exhibitors under the age of 6 must be accompanied by a handler in the ring.

You have the option to show off your trailer or rent a stall for the day of the show. There is a designated wash area as well as electric if needed or welcome to bring a generator.

The show chairman and committee reserve the final right to interpret these rules, settle and determine all matters and questions arising from or connected to the Winter Classic Jackpot Show. Any exhibitor who violates the rules will forfeit all privileges and such penalties as the committee may deem reasonable.

An official certificate of veterinary inspection must be presented at time of check-in dated within 90 days (within 30 days for out of state animals) of show.

The exhibitor is liable for any damages his/her goat may incur and also for the safety of his/her goats. Winter Classic Jackpot Show assumes no responsibility or liability for any damages. If any goat is a threat to the public the animal will be removed from the show area. Poor sportsmanship (as determined by the show committee) will not be tolerated. The judge's decision is final and should be respected.

Show Rules: Dairy does, meat does and meat bucks will be shown by age and broken into separate classes. Class scheduled is reflected on the following page. Market goats will be shown by weight and will be weighed at check-in. List of classes will be posted after check-in is completed. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champions will be awarded and receive a payout. Showmanship will be divided into peewee (7 and under), junior (8-11), intermediate (12-14), senior (15-18, has not graduated High School) and adult divisions (has graduated High School and older). Exhibitors have the option to use any goat entered on their entry form for Showmanship.

There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the show. A minimum of 10 animals are required to have each division. The show committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as necessary.
