- **Brahman and Commercial Bulls**
- **Following Bull Shows we will move into Showmanship beginning with 8 y/o.**
- **At the conclusion of showmanship we will have the Brahman Influenced Heifer Show.**

**The show order on Saturday is as follows:**

- **8:00 AM-** Steers Show- American Steers then Commercial Steers followed by Bred and Owned Steer Show
- **20 Minute Break**
- Register Brahman Females, Brangus Females followed by Brahman Influenced Bred and Owned
- **10 Minute Break**
- Commercial Heifers then AOB Heifers, followed by Commercial Heifer Bred and Owned
- Supreme Heifer Drive

**Entries:**

***PRE- ENTRIES ONLY (No Entries will be accepted the day of the show!)***

- 1) Entries are \$35 per head with an additional \$10 fee for bred and owned**

### **SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES:**

**Entry Fee for showmanship will be \$20.00.**

**Showmanship will start Friday night following the bull show: Juniors (8-11), Intermediates (12-14), then Seniors (15-18 not graduated from high school). All exhibitors must show their own animals in the showmanship competition. Age is based on the age of the exhibitor on July 30, 2020**

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. All exhibitors must be active members of JFCA, 4-H or FFA between the ages of 8-21
2. Each exhibitor/owner must assume liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
3. The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animals.  
**Bring your own Shavings**
4. Bring generators, electricity is limited. No Generators permitted under the barn! Generators must be outside in designated grooming areas and must be shut off upon request.
5. Trailers must be parked in designated parking areas.
6. Any violation may result in the disqualification of the animal and the exhibitor. If disqualified, all premiums and entry fees will be forfeited.
7. All persons inside the barn area should be clothed in appropriate barn attire at all times, including closed toed shoes.

### **SHOW REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All Steers, Commercial Heifers, Brahman Influenced Heifers, and Commercial Bulls will be shown by weight. Brahman cattle, AOB heifers, and Brangus heifers will be shown by birthdate. Cattle must be weighed at time of check-in. Please note on entry form if heifer or steer is Brahman influenced.
2. All cattle classes will be determined by show committee.
3. Bulls must be no older than 24 months as of July 30, 2019 and must be shown with a nose ring.

4. All Heifers must be no older than 36 months old at the time of the show.
5. Bred and Owned Steers and Heifers: ● Exhibitor must mark that calf is Bred and Owned. Must be Breeder, 1<sup>st</sup>, and continuous owner! ● Bred and Owned Steer/Heifer will show within the regular steer/Heifer class. The Highest placed Bred and Owned Steers/Heifers from each class will be brought back to the Bred and Owned Steer/Heifer Final Drive.
6. Must be a registered member of JFCA to qualify for points. Membership dues will be taken at show if necessary.

### ***HEALTH REGULATIONS:***

1. All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the Rules for Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services. All cattle must have current health papers.
2. Cattle will be inspected before off-loading trailer

### ***PREMIUMS:***

- GRAND CHAMPION Steer and Supreme Heifer will receive \$250 & an award
  - RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION Steer and Reserve Supreme Heifer will receive \$125 and an award
  - Overall 3-5 will receive an award
  - CLASS PLACINGS 1-3 WILL RECEIVE A PREMIUM 1st- \$35.00 2nd- \$25.00 3rd - \$15.00
  - Champion Showman per division will receive a Belt Buckle
  - Top 5 Bulls, American Steers, Brahman Influenced heifers, Brangus heifers Commercial heifers, AOB heifers, Brangus heifers, and Brahman Heifers will be recognized
- \* Concession Stand will be open at the show.
