Entry

Fees

Entries and Fees will be open **November 2nd through December 4th**.

No late entries will be accepted.

Entries

All entries will be done using the Showman online entry form. This show is open to any showman ages of 18 years old and younger. All exhibitors along with their parent or legal guardian must complete and sign the entry form. Entry forms along with entry fee \$35.00 per animal, \$20.00 for showmanship and \$10.00 grounds fee must be turned in by December 4th.

Health Regulations

All animals must have an official health certificate issued by an accredited vet. Each exhibitor will assume all liability in case of injury or death to his/her animal. No animal will be off loaded until checked in by a Department of Agriculture representative.

Show Rules

Open to exhibitors 18 years old and younger. If exhibitor is under 6 years old there must be a handler present in ring to assist.

Steers

Classes will be established by weight. Steers will be weighed in at time of check-in between 7:00 and 9:00 AM on Saturday, December 19th, 2020. After all animals are weighed and checked-in, the show committee will establish classes for the steers. Steers will be divided into four divisions (Black, Red, Light, and American). Ex: Black Division = Black, Black n white, Black Baldies.

Red = Red, Red n White, Red Baldies

Light = White, Yellow, Smoke, or any other light-colored category mixed or solid

American = Brahman influenced cattle of any color

Heifers

Commercial heifer classes will be established by weight. Heifers will be weighed in at time of check-in between 7:00 and 9:00 AM on Saturday, December 19th, 2020. After all animals are weighed and checked-in, the show committee will establish classes. All commercial animals will be sorted by weight. Breed classes will be designated for any breed with more than 10 registered animals, in which those breeds will be sorted by age. Any registered breed that does not have 10 head will be moved into the commercial classes, and shown by weight.

Heifers must be 3 years old or less.

Bulls

All bulls must have a nose ring or tong during the show or anytime the animal is not tied. All bulls must be manageable. All commercial bulls will be sorted by weight, unless there are over 10 registered bulls to create a breed division, in which case it will be sorted by age. Bulls must be 24 months old or less

Showmanship_____

There will be a showmanship contest held for cattle. The showmanship contest is an additional \$20.00 fee. The divisions are: Pee-Wee (7 and under), Junior (8 to 11), Intermediate (12 to 14), and Senior (15 to 18), as of November 2nd, 2020. Exhibitor must show their own animal and it must be entered in a show class.

Shade, Generators and Wash Racks_____

There will be no shade or tie-outs available. Please bring your own shade. Remember the show is in the middle of December and it can be hot! There will be **NO** ties in the barn or arena area; you must tie to your trailer. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide his/her own power for cooling and grooming their animals. There is a limited supply of water and wash rack facilities. It is recommended by the Show Committee that exhibitors wash before arriving to the show or bring equipment to assist them in cleaning their animals. **Please clean your area prior to leaving the facility.**

T-Shirts_____

All exhibitors will receive a T-shirt. Please place sizes in the line provided on the entry form. If you have registered more than one exhibitor, please make sure all sizes are listed. If a family wants to purchase extra shirts, please not this on the registration form. There will be a limited amount for sale the day of the show.
