



Chipley Jackpot Swine & Cattle Showcase



General Rules

1. Show will be at the Jackson County Agriculture Center 3631 US 90 Marianna, Florida 32446
2. Show and showmanship will be for ages 8-18
3. Pee wee showmanship for ages 3-7 must be accompanied by adult or senior showman, no charge (no payout but will receive a prize).
4. Livestock must be shown by exhibitor, unless he/she has multiple entries per class, then he/she may designate another registered exhibitor to show for them.
5. All livestock must have a form of identification (tattoo and/or tag or ear notch system)
6. Out of state entries must follow state of Florida entry requirements. Livestock within state must follow state requirements for exhibition.
7. All entries are required to be seen by the USDA inspector when you arrive. If you are showing off the trailer you will still need to go through the inspection zone before parking or offloading.
8. Show officials reserve the right to make decisions deemed to be in the interest of the show. (Ex. Unruly/aggressive livestock will be penned and not allowed to continue)
9. No one associated with the show is liable for accidents, injury, theft, missing or damaged property.
10. No generators allowed inside the barn.
11. All entries must be postmarked by November 25, 2020. A late fee of \$10.00 per head will be required after this date.

13. Show will be jackpot style, payout will be top three winners of each class in prospect swine, market swine and steer. Payout to top three heifer division winners. Showmanship will payout top five in each division.

14. Grand and Reserve will be awarded for Prospect Swine, Market Swine and Steer.

15. Supreme/Reserve Champion will be awarded for Heifers.

16. Show schedule is as follows:

- Friday check in will begin at 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Swine Showmanship classes start at 5:00 p.m.
- Swine Prospect (50-199 lbs.) classes to follow showmanship, followed by grand drive.
- Swine Market (200 – 320 lbs.) classes followed by grand drive.
- Saturday morning check in from 7:00 – 9:00 a.m.
- Cattle Showmanship classes start at 11:00 a.m.
- Steer weight classes followed by grand drive
- Heifer divisions (commercial/breed)
- Heifer supreme drive

17. Showmanship will be broken up into groups:

- Pee wee (3-7 years)
- Junior (8-10 years)
- Intermediate (11-13 years)
- Senior A (14-15 years)
- Senior B (16-18 years)

Swine Show Guidelines:

- Barrows and Gilts only
- Limit 3 hogs per exhibitor
- Prospect swine 50-199 lbs.
- Market swine 200-320 lbs.
- Limited number of pens available. Showing from the trailer is encouraged. If using pens and you have multiple entries, you may be asked to double pen. Bring a divider if needed. No hogs are to be clipped, carried, restrained, or harassed in any way to cause undue stress on the animal.

Cattle Show Guidelines:

- Limit 3 head of cattle per exhibitor.
- Commercial heifers and steers will be shown by weight.
- Breed heifers will be shown by age/birthdate (No cattle born before September 2018)
- Cow/calf pairs will be accepted.
- Exhibitor will declare breed or commercial on entry form.
- No clipping allowed in the barn.
- All cattle must be properly halter broken and lead in a manageable fashion to be eligible for show.
