## ENTRIES:

- \$35 per entry - **On-line Entries Only**
- Entries will be accepted at check-in, but pre-entries are strongly encouraged.
- In order to guarantee you receive a hat, you must be registered by Wednesday, December 23, 2020
- You may register an additional or substitute an animal the day of check-in.
- There will be **NO REFUNDS**

## SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES:

Entry Fee for showmanship will be \$20.00.

- PeeWee (4-7),
- Juniors (8-11),
- Intermediates (12-14),
- Seniors (15-18 not graduated from high school)
- Collegiate (18 -21 has graduated high school).

**All exhibitors must show their own animals in showmanship, except for collegiate. Age is based on the age of the exhibitor on December 31, 2020**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- All exhibitors must be active members of 4-H or FFA between the ages of 8-21.
- Each exhibitor/owner must assume liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
- Stalls will be available for \$25. The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animals.
- Grooming chutes will be limited to one per exhibitor. Grooming chutes must be confined to areas designated.
- Bring generators, electricity is limited. No Generators permitted under the barn! Generators must be outside in designated grooming areas and must be shut off

upon request.

- Trailers must be parked in designated parking areas.
- All persons inside the barn area should always be clothed in appropriate barn attire, including closed toed shoes.
- Disrespectful, vulgar, inappropriate behavior – including but not limited to language, underage drinking, interaction with adults, judges, show officials, will not be tolerated. Participating in any of these activities will be grounds for IMMEDIATE dismissal. The final decision of the committee will be non-negotiable.
- Any violation may result in the disqualification of the animal and exhibitor. If disqualified, all premiums and entry fees will be forfeited.
- Please help us by cleaning up after yourself in the barn, tie-out area, trailer parking areas, etc. There will be garbage cans and manure bins scattered for your convenience.

### **HEALTH REGULATIONS:**

- All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the Rules for Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services. All cattle must have current health papers.
- Cattle will be inspected before off-loading trailer.
- No filling/pumping of cattle with any substance, water included, is strictly prohibited

- GRAND CHAMPION \$200 and a buckle
- RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION \$100 and a buckle
- THIRD, FOURTH FIFTH will receive an award
- CLASS PLACINGS 1-3 will receive a premium
  - 1st- \$35.00
  - 2nd- \$20.00
  - 3rd - \$10.00
- TOP SHOWMAN per division will receive a belt buckle
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> overall will receive an award
