



# Market Lamb and Breeding Ewe Show

On-line Entries Only

## ENTRIES:

- \$25 per entry - **On-line Entries Only**
- Entries will be accepted at check-in, but pre-entries are strongly encouraged.
- In order to guarantee that you receive a hat, you must be registered by Wednesday, December 23, 2020
- You may register an additional or substitute an animal the day of check-in.
- There will be **NO REFUNDS**

## SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES:

Entry Fee for showmanship will be \$10.00.

- Peewee: 2nd grade and under
- Junior: 3rd-5th grade
- Intermediate: 6th-8th grade
- Senior: 9th-12th grade

Age is based on the age of the exhibitor on December 27, 2020.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS:

**This show will be eligible for JSFA Points**

**Market Lambs -**

- Classes will be determined by weight upon weigh-in.
- All weigh-ins are first come, first served, No exceptions.
- Each animal will be allowed will be walked across the scale 1 time only. You may be allowed to re-walk your animal across the scale only if there is a scale malfunction. This will be determined by the FYLE Designee and the Weigh Master
- Ewes may be shown in the market lamb show.
- The market lamb show will not be broken down into separate divisions
- Top 5 Market Lambs will be selected.

**Breeding Ewes** - Breeding ewes will be shown by age and placed into the following divisions: black face ewes, white face ewes, AOB and Haired/exotic ewes.

- All breeding ewes must be 48 months of age or under.
- Division Champions: Top 5 breeding ewes will be selected.
- Class, Divisions and Champion Drive are subject to change based on amount of entries.

**Breeding Rams** - There is no Breeding Ram show

Fitting, Shade, Generators and Wash Racks: THIS IS A BLOW AND GO SHOW. As per JSAF policy, full body clipping and shearing is highly discouraged on show day. To allow for adequate health inspection and to limit the amount of waste left behind, exhibitors observed performing full body clipping will be asked to stop and the affected animal and/or exhibitor may be disqualified from the show. Small touch ups and blocking with clippers are permitted. While the facility has pens available, we highly encourage all exhibitors to show off of their trailers. Please bring your own shade, pens/tie-outs, power or generators, if needed. Wash racks will be available, please be courteous and allow fellow exhibitors to use them alongside of you. It is also recommended that exhibitors wash before arriving at the show and bring all equipment to assist them in preparing their animals for show

- All animals must have an Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (OCVI) (health papers), issued by an accredited veterinarian, at time of check-in. Animals must be free of ringworm and are subject to the health requirements of the State of Florida.
- All decisions made by the judge & show committee will be final.
- All goats or sheep entered for exhibition purposes must have an official individual identification in accordance with the National Scrapie Eradication Uniform Methods and Rules, APHIS 91-55-066, June 1, 2005.
- Market lambs must have their milk teeth in place at the time of showing and be slick-shorn.
- Market lamb classes will be divided according to weight.
- Ewes or wethers are eligible for market lamb classes, however animals shown as market lambs are not eligible to compete in any other divisions.
- Breeding ewe classes will be divided according to age.
- Must have 10 entries in each division, otherwise entries will show in A.O.B.
- Number of classes and weight breaks will be determined by the show committee on show day.
- Any wether showing evidence of testicular tissue will be ineligible to show.
- Wethers and ewes will be eligible for the show. Market lambs and breeding ewes will be shown separately. Winners from individual classes in all divisions will be brought back together to compete for the top five Overall Individuals.

- Bracing lambs will be allowed.
- There will be no limit on the number of entries an exhibitor enters.
- Exhibitors must show their own lamb in class. If the exhibitor has more than one lamb in class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
- Each exhibitor/owner must assume liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
- Trailers must be parked in designated parking areas.
- 12 x 12 stalls with are available for use, free of charge, including electrical outlets. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their pens used before premiums are paid. Shavings will be available for purchase, if needed.
- Any violation may result in the disqualification of the animal and the exhibitor. If disqualified, all premiums and entry fees will be forfeited.
- All persons inside the barn area should always be clothed in appropriate barn attire, including closed toed shoes.

### PREMIUMS:

- GRAND CHAMPION Market Lamb will receive a cash prize and buckle.
- RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION Market Lamb will receive cash prize and award.
- THIRD, FOURTH and FIFTH OVERALL Market Lamb will receive an award.
- GRAND CHAMPION Black Face, White Face, AOB, Hair /Exotic Ewe will receive a buckle
- RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION Black Face, White Face, AOB, Hair /Exotic Ewe Black Face, White Face, AOB, Hair /Exotic Ewe will receive an award.
- Third, Fourth, and Fifth Black Face, White Face, AOB, Hair /Exotic Ewe will receive an award
- GRAND CHAMPION Overall Breeding Ewe (“Supreme Ewe”) will receive a cash prize and award .
- RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION (“Reserve Supreme Ewe” Overall Breeding Ewe will receive a cash prize and award.
- THIRD, FOURTH and FIFTH OVERALL Breeding Ewes will receive an award.
- Class Placings 1-3 will receive premiums
  - 1<sup>st</sup> - \$25.00
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$15.00
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$10.00
- TOP SHOWMAN per division will receive a buckle (excluding Peewee)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> overall will receive an award
