General Rules:

All rules of the ABGA must be followed. The show chairman and committee reserve the final right to interpret these rules, settle and determine all matters and questions arising from or connected to the Sunshine State Classic. Any exhibitor who violates the rules will forfeit all privileges and such penalties as the committee may deem reasonable.

An official certificate of veterinary inspection must be presented at time of check-in dated within 90 days (within 30 days for out of state animals) of show.

****Showmanship will be held on Sunday morning in conjunction with the Winter Classic Jackpot Show. If you wish to participate in Showmanship or the Winter Classic Jackpot Show please be sure to fill out and send in that shows entry form and fees which can be found on the Winter Classic Jackpot Show FB page. The Winter Classic Jackpot Show will have meat doe, meat buck, market goat and dairy doe divisions. Commercial and registered goats are allowed. If you have any questions on this please contact me.****

Animals must be registered with ABGA. Animals under 3 months old and are entered on pending applications must show proof that the application has been submitted to the ABGA by either a stamped duplicate or faxed application stamped by the ABGA with the date received. Originals of registration papers must be presented at time of check-in, copies are prohibited. If an animal is recently registered using ABGA Online Live, there

is a temporary certificate good to show with that expires 30 days after registering that will be accepted prior to its expiration. The base date to compute age for classes will be the date of the show. All entries will be shown by age according to their registration certificate. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the show. The show committee reserves the right to combine or split classes into heats as necessary.

Aisle, stall and stall area are to be kept neat and free from obstructing the walkway. Shavings will be in the pens. If you would like additional shavings feel free to bring what you would like to further bed down your pens. There is a designated wash area. Electric is available in a designated area of the barn where you can set up stands or the use of generators is allowed as well.

The exhibitor is liable for any damages his/her goat may incur and also for the safety of his/her goats. The Sunshine State Classic assumes no responsibility or liability for any damages. If any goat (or exhibitor) is a threat to the public the animal (or exhibitor) will be removed from the facility grounds. Poor sportsmanship (as determined by the show committee) will not be tolerated. The judge's decision is final and should be respected.
