Friday December 4th:

- 9:00 am – Gates will open - you will be inspected at the gate before entering
 - Please use the Red Gate for entrance – Orient Rd – signs will be posted
- 11 am – 5 pm - Weigh-In & Check-In (in the show arena)
- 6:00 pm Showmanship – two rings, order and classes TBD
- **SPECIAL NOTES –**
 - Following showmanship, we will have a **FUN White Elephant Gift Exchange in Arena** – this is open to all exhibitors and siblings/friends/family of exhibitors - **if you will be participating in the exchange**, please bring a wrapped gift (up to \$20 in value). Parents are welcome to come spectate!
 - We will also hold a **Toy Drive during this show** – if you would like to participate in our drive, please bring a new, unopened, unwrapped toy with you to the show and drop it off at the show office! We appreciate your kind donations!

***At the conclusion of ALL the female shows, we will hold the Supreme Heifer Drive - which will consist of ALL the Grand Champions from the Female Divisions. Reserves will be eligible to come back for the Top 5's.*

ENTRIES:

- **Entries will be completed through – www.showman.app and will close on December 1st.**
- ***PRE- ENTRIES ONLY (No Entries will be accepted the day of the show!)***
- **Entries are \$35 per head with an additional \$10 fee for bred and owned**
- **ABSOLUTLEY NO REFUNDS**

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES:

- Entry Fee for showmanship will be \$20.00.
- There will **no charge** for PeeWee Showmanship – however pre-registration is highly encouraged! Signups will also take place onsite during check-in (11 am – 5 pm)
- We will be offering Collegiate Showmanship at this show, entry fee is \$20
- Showmanship will be held Friday night and conducted in two rings.
- Order to be determined by check in.
- All exhibitors must show their own animals in the showmanship competition. Age is based on the age of the exhibitor on July 30, 2020

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All exhibitors must be current members of JFCA, 4-H or FFA between the ages of 8-21
2. Each exhibitor/owner must assume liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
3. The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animals.
4. Bring generators, electricity will be limited to the perimeters of the cattle barn. No Generators permitted inside the barn! Generators must be outside in designated grooming areas and must be shut off upon request.
5. We will have some stalling available inside the cattle barns. These spaces will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. On site tie-outs are also available for use.
6. NO BEDDING allowed inside the barns in stalling area.
7. Trailers must be parked in designated parking areas.
8. Any violation may result in the disqualification of the animal and the exhibitor. If disqualified, all premiums and entry fees will be forfeited.
9. All persons inside the barn area should be clothed in appropriate barn attire at all times, including closed toed shoes.

SHOW REQUIREMENTS:

1. All Steers, Commercial Heifers, Brahman Influenced Heifers, and Commercial Bulls will be shown by weight. All Brahman cattle (heifers and bulls), AOB heifers, and Brangus heifers will be shown by birthdate. Cattle must be weighed at time of check-in. Please note on entry form if heifer or steer is Brahman influenced.
2. All cattle classes will be determined by show committee.
3. Bulls must be no older than 24 months as of July 30, 2020 and must be shown with a nose ring.
4. All Heifers must be no older than 36 months old at the time of the show.
5. Bred and Owned Steers and Heifers:
 - Exhibitor must mark that calf is Bred and Owned. Must be Breeder, 1st, and continuous owner!
 - Bred and Owned Steer/Heifer will show within the regular Steer/Heifer class. The Highest placed Bred and Owned Steers/Heifers from each class will be brought back to the Bred and Owned Steer/Heifer Final Drive.
6. Must be a registered member of JFCA to qualify for points. Membership dues will be taken at show if necessary, but can be done by visiting www.floridacattlemen.org and click the "Join" tab.

HEALTH REGULATIONS:

1. All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the Rules for Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services. All cattle must have current health papers.
2. Cattle will be inspected before off-loading trailer

PREMIUMS:

- GRAND CHAMPION Steer and Supreme Heifer will receive \$250 & an award
- RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION Steer and Reserve Supreme Heifer will receive \$125 and an award
- Overall 3-5 will receive an award
- CLASS PLACINGS 1-3 WILL RECEIVE A PREMIUM
- Champion Showman per division will receive an award and premium.
- Top 5 - Bulls, American Steers, Brahman Influenced Heifers, Brangus Heifers, Commercial Heifers, AOB Heifers, Brangus Heifers, and Brahman Heifers will be recognized with an award
