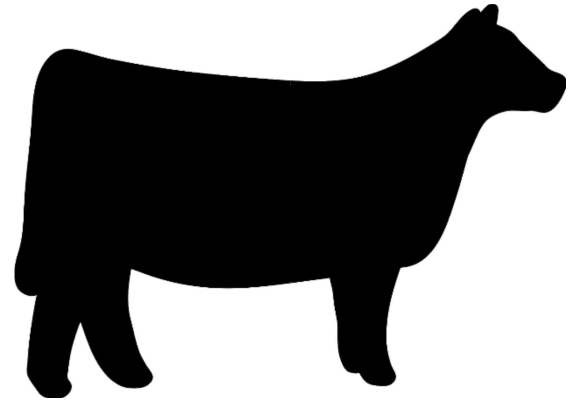


# 2nd Annual Volusia County Jr Cattlemen's Association

## Battle of the Beef



**Date:** February 6<sup>TH</sup> & 7<sup>TH</sup> , 2021

**Location:** Volusia County Cattlemen's Arena – Intrastate 4 and S.R. 44

**Saturday February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Check In:** 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm

**Showmanship Saturday February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Show Start:** 7:00 pm

**Saturday February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Check In:** 6:00 am – 8:00 am

**Sunday February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Show Start:** 9:30 am

### **Entry Fees:**

Pre-entries & Fees must be postmarked by Jan. 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Cattle: \$30.00 for the first head and \$20 for each additional head.

Showmanship: \$15.00

There will be a \$10 late fee/per exhibitor entered after the Jan.18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 deadline.

There will be a \$35.00 return check fee for any check(s) that are returned for insufficient funds.

Cash Only day of show.

### **General Show Rules:**

**MASKS ARE HIGH ENCOURAGED WHILE ON PROPERTY AND IN SHOW RING.**

Show is open to any 4H or FFA member who is currently enrolled in High School or below, members must be in good standing with their club, chapter or association. All exhibitors must sign the entry form with their parent/guardian.

All cattle will be classified at time of weigh in.

All animals must have an official health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian at the time of check in. All animals must be free of lice and are subject to health requirements of the state of Florida.

All exhibitors under the age of 6 will be required to have a handler in the ring during the show and showmanship.

It is strictly the judge's decision on callbacks for the Top 5.

Classes will be set with a minimum of 3 head.

**Show Rules:**

*Steers:*

Classes will be established by weight. Steers will be weighed at time of check-in between 7:00 am – 8:30am. After all animals are checked in the committee will establish classes for steers. Steers will be combined AOB and Brahman Influence.

Division Champions will be recognized. Supreme Champion Drive: top 5 steers will be selected.

*Bulls:*

There will be no bull show.

*Heifers:*

Classes will be established by weight. Heifers will be weighed in at time of check-in between 7:00 am – 8:30 am. After all animals are checked in the committee will establish classes for heifers. Heifers will be divided by AOB and Brahman Influence. There must be a minimum of 10 heifers in each division to make a separate show; otherwise it will be a combined show.

\*\* All heifers must be under 30 months of age.

Division champions will be recognized. Supreme Champion Drive: top 5 heifers will be selected.

**Shade, Generators, and Wash Racks:**

There will be no shade or tie outs available. Please bring your own shade. There will be no barn ties. You must tie to your trailer.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide their own power for cooling/grooming their animals.

There is a limited supply of water and wash facilities. It is recommended by the show committee that exhibitors wash prior to arrival or bring equipment to assist them in cleaning their animal.

It is of the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean your area before leaving.

**Ethical Treatment:**

All animals are expected to be treated in a humane manner. Failure to comply may result in the exhibitor and/or animal(s) to be disqualified.

**Interpretation of the rules:**

The committee reserves the right to amend, add to or interpret the above rules and following rules and regulations.
