Entry Fees/ Deadlines:

- ALL registration will be done online at showman.app
- \$30.00 per head of cattle
- \$15.00 per exhibitor to enter showmanship (Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Collegiate)
- \$10.00 for Pee Wee Showmanship
- To be guaranteed a shirt, exhibitors must register by January 18, 2021
- A late fee of \$10.00 per exhibitor for entries after January 18, 2021
- **Online registrations will close on January 28, at 11:59pm**
- Only Cash accepted on the day of show
- There is no maximum number of entries per exhibitors
- NO REFUNDS will be issued

Showmanship:

- \$15.00 for exhibitors in Junior, Intermediate, Senior, and Collegiate Showmanship
- \$10.00 for Pee Wee Showmanship
- Showmanship entry deadline is January 28, 2021 at 11:59pm
- **Day of Show showmanship entries WILL NOT be accepted**
- There will be (4) age divisions: as of January 29, 2021.

Pee Wee: 7- under
 Junior: 8-11
 Intermediate: 12-14
 Senior: 15-18
 Collegiate: 19-21

Health Regulations:

- All cattle must have an Official Health Certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian.
- No cattle will be allowed off trailers until health papers are verified and cattle are cleared by USDA State Inspectors.

Rules and Regulations:

1. The show will be open to all youth from any state under 21 years of age as of January 29, 2021 (day of the show).
2. All cattle must be under 36 months of age as of January 29, 2021 (day of show).
3. All bulls **MUST** have a nose ring.
4. All bulls, steers, and commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
5. For the Registered AOB Show, cattle will be shown by age in alphabetical order by breed division. **Must have 10 head or more for a breed division.**
6. For the Registered AOB Show, all exhibitors must prove paperwork to be in the AOB Show.

7. The judge's decision is FINAL in all classes.
8. Barn space will be on a first come first serve basis.
9. Electricity is limited so generators are highly recommended.
10. Exhibitors must wear a collared shirt, jeans, and closed toed shoes in the arena.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their area prior to leaving the barn.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and clean-up of any area used at the Clay County Fairgrounds.
13. The show committee reserves the right to amend, add to and interpret the rules as they see fit. Any issues need to be brought to the show committee.
14. All cattle must be treated in an ethical and humane manner. Any violation may result in disqualification of animal and exhibitor. **Fees will not be refunded.** .
15. All cattle must clearly be identified with ear tags.
16. No pets allowed on fairgrounds on day of shows, except for easily identifiable service animals.
17. At the ending of the show, ALL cattle must be off the fairgrounds within 3 hours.
18. The exhibitor and a parent or legal guardian must sign all entry forms.
19. Entry forms must be signed, complete, and received with entry fee to be accepted.
20. The show committee, Clay County Board of Commissioners, Clay County Cattlemen's Corporation, nor the Clay County Fair Association will be responsible for any accidents or injuries that occur.
21. The Show committee, Clay County Board of Commissioners, Clay County Cattlemen's Corporation, nor the Clay County Fair Association will be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items or damages to personal property.
